

#### **SPLIT TO SPLIT LUXURY CRUISE**

A luxury cruise that starts and finishes in the spectacular city of Split and visits many of Croatia's historic Adriatic ports: Dubrovnik, Hvar and Korcula as well as Mljet National Park. You can swim every day in a secluded bay, and in the evenings you are free to explore the restaurants of the towns and ports that we spend the nights in. There is plenty of time to explore ashore most days or you can relax on the sun deck with a book and a long drink.



#### **ITINERARY**

Day 1 SPLIT ARRIVAL, Saturday (WR, D)

You will be transferred from Split's airport to Split Harbour, where embarkation begins at 14:00h. Get settled in your cabin before attending a Welcome Reception followed by dinner this evening.

Day 2 SPLIT - BOL - JELSA, Sunday (B, L)

Morning sail towards Bol on Bra Island, where you will discover one of the most beautiful beaches in the entire Mediterranean - "Zlatni Rat" (the Golden Horn), which is constantly changing its shape due to the ocean currents. Swim stop if weather permits. Return to the ship for lunch and set sail for Jelsa on the island of Hvar. One of the most picturesque towns on the island of Hvar; Jelsa is nestled in amongst hills dense with pine woods. The



town quay extends all the way around the harbour with numerous laid moorings. Walk around the town's an old stone street, squares, see churches, and parks. Enjoy a coffee in the main square and soak up the Mediterranean atmosphere of this bustling town. Your evening is free to explore Jelsa on your own.

Day 3 JELSA - KOR ULA (Wine tasting), Monday (B, L, T)

Early in the morning we set sail for the island of Kor ula, with swim stop, weather permitting, in one of pristine bays, time to relax and lunch on board. Continue towards Kor ula, the most preserved medieval town, thought to be the birthplace of the famous explorer Marco Polo. Take a walking tour of Kor ula which takes you through its narrow, cobbled streets full of history and enjoy wine tasting in one of the local wine bars. Evening is free to explore the town on your own

Day 4 KOR ULA - DUBROVNIK, Tuesday (B, L

In the morning sail to Dubrovnik, the "Pearl of the Adriatic", a famous UNESCO World Heritage site. Upon arrival in Dubrovnik, you will enjoy a guided tour of the historical centre of Dubrovnik, walk through STRADUN - both a street and a square, the most famous place inside the town walls, where your guide will show you the most interesting sights of Dubrovnik. After city tour, you will be on your own to explore the city, visit City Walls, the Franciscan Monastery with Europe's second oldest pharmacy, the Rector's Palace, and the Cathedral, or take a boat ride to Lokrum island or take the cable car to the top of the Mount Sr . Overnight in Dubrovnik.

Day 5 DUBROVNIK - MLJET National Park, Wednesday (B, L, CD)

In the morning head further north to the Island of Mljet. Mljet National Park encompasses five types of forest, many species of birds and two deep lakes, Veliko Jezero (Big Lake) and Malo Jezero (Small Lake). Join the Cruise Manager for a stroll to the famous salt lakes in the Mljet National Park. Alternatively, you can rent bicycles, scooters, or kayaks to explore the National Park or island on your own. Tonight, enjoy Captain's dinner on board.

Day 6 MLJET National Park - HVAR, Thursday (B, L)

Take a break for a swim during your morning cruise. Continue sailing through lunch, arriving this afternoon in Hvar, a charming seaside town with 8 centuries of architecture, and also a favourite holiday destination for international celebrities. During a walking tour, visit the many historical sights of the town, such as St Stephen's Square and Cathedral, the Arsenal with the theatre built on its first floor, the first municipal theatre in Europe. Above Hvar Town is the impressive fortress Fortica offering magnificent views over the bay and Pakleni islands. Your evening is free in Hvar. You can explore more and dine on your own at one of the many restaurants in town.

Day 7 HVAR - SPLIT, Friday (B, L)

Next, we head to our final port Split with a stop along the way to swim, cool off and relax, if weather permits, with lunch on board. In the late afternoon we arrive in Split to take a walking tour of





the historic inner city takes us to the Palace of the Roman Emperor Diocletian, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. We see the remnants of Split's Roman heritage, its Renaissance and Gothic structures, Jupiter's Temple, the Peristyle, and the Cathedral. Your evening is free in Split.

There are several similar ships that are used for these cruises, Desire, My Way, Prestige & Arca. The wonderful M/S Desire, launched in 2017, is a state-of-the-art vessel with the latest equipment and amenities. Maximum capacity is 38 passengers in 19 twin, double and triple cabins, guaranteeing an intimate setting for all guests. At 48 metres long she is one of the roomier vessels to be found along this coastline. All cabins have are fully equipped with A/C, LCD TV, safe deposit box, fire alarm, internal communication system between room and bar. Bathrooms are equipped with toilet, shower, wash basin, hair dryer, slippers, bathrobe, and for added convenience cosmetic package. All cabins are sound-proof and each cabin comes with the fire-proof doors. A fully air-conditioned upper deck dining room can accommodate all passengers at once, yet offer a great degree of privacy for each guest. The restaurant is equipped with a bar and LCD TV, and each table has easy-access chairs. There is also a corner table for buffet breakfast, armchair and small coffee table in the bar, as well as free wireless internet (Wi-Fi), loudspeakers, audio-system, and a direct telephone communication cabin-bar. The kitchen is made in line with the latest HACCP standards. An extension of the restaurant is


outdoors, on the covered part of the upper deck, spacious enough for all passengers and tables, chairs and including one public lavatory. Electricity on
